"Destined to Be Crowned" Hebrews 2:5-9 December 3, 2023

I. Explanation of Hebrews 2:5-9

- A. The "world to come" (i.e. "age to come") refers to the culminating age of redeemed humanity.
 - 1. The complete in-breaking of this coming age is in the future.
 - But because of Christ's exaltation, aspects of this age are breaking into our present.

Hebrews 6:5 - and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come...

- B. The quotation from Ps. 8 shows God's ultimate plan for mankind.
 - 1. Man was created to rule over all things crowned with glory and honor.
 - a. However, presently, man doesn't rule over much at all, not even on earth.
 - b. This is, of course, due to humanity's rebellion.
 - 2. Despite fallen mankind's failure, Jesus has been exalted to humanity's ultimate destiny.
 - a. He reigns over all things in heaven and on earth.
 - b. He has been crowned with glory and honor.
 - c. Jesus fulfills God's original intent for mankind, including ruling over the angels in the "world to come".

II. Implications of Hebrews 2:5-9

- A. Despite how out of control things appear in this world and in our lives, we must remember that Jesus rules it all.
 - 1. This is mean to be a source of great comfort.
 - 2. Seeing Jesus reigning over all should supply us with peace and strength (Eph. 6:10).
- B. Jesus' present reign also provides with us a sure hope for our future.
 - 1. Christ came into our world not just to be exalted over it according to His humanity...
 - a. He came so that we might share in His exaltation.
 - b. He came to "bring many sons to glory" (Heb. 2:10).
 - c. Being crowned with glory and honor is our destiny.
 - 2. Our exaltation is already true in principle.

Ephesians 2:6 and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus...



- 3. A hope of a future like this should fill us with great courage in the present.
- 4. This same hope also reminds us that our present tragedies will not define us forever (and do not need to define us now).
- 5. In addition, this hope calls us to put aside aspects of our *present* life that are inconsistent with our *future* glory and honor.
- C. Such incredible blessings have come and will come our way because of God's glorious grace alone.
