I. Christian fellowship is grounded in truth and love. (2 John 1-2)

- A. Christians love one another "in the truth", i.e., the truth about Jesus.
- B. Christians love one another for the sake of that truth.

John 14:6 - Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life..."

1 John 1:7 - but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

II. Christian hope is grounded in truth and love. (2 John 3)

- A. Divine grace, mercy, and peace will always be with believers *in* truth and love.
- B. Outside of Christian truth and Christian love, there is no hope of grace, mercy, and peace.

III. Christian obedience commands truth and love. (2 John 4-6)

- A. Walking in the truth is a twofold command:
 - 1 John 3:23 This is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us.
- B. Christians are commanded to believe the truth about Jesus.
- C. Christians are to love one another as Jesus has commanded:
 - **John 15:12–13** ¹² This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends.
