"You're Going from 'TOHU and BOHU' to 'Very Good'" Bible Stories, Pt. 1: Genesis 1:1-2:3

I. Genesis 1:1-2:3 tells the true story of Creation.

- A. It is the story of a *God* who creates.
 - 1. This conflicts with our culture's story of a time and chance universe.
 - 2. This sets the foundation for a true, authoritative morality.
- B. It is the story of a *Triune* God who creates.
 - 1. This conflicts with other religious beliefs of a solitary creator.
 - 2. God's relational essence provides the foundation for a morality that is not just authoritative, but lovely.
- C. It is the story of the *centrality* of Earth and the *supremacy* of Humanity.
 - 1. Earth is made first. Everything else in the universe is made for it.
 - 2. Humanity, as God's royal image bearers, is the pinnacle of creation.

II. Genesis 1:1-2:3 tells the true story of Redemption.

Deuteronomy 32:10–11 - ¹⁰ "He found him [Israel] in a desert land, And in the howling <u>waste</u> [Gen. 1:2] of a wilderness; He encircled him, He cared for him, He guarded him as the pupil of His eye. ¹¹ "Like an eagle that stirs up its nest, That <u>hovers</u> [Gen. 1:2] over its young, He spread His wings and caught them, He carried them on His pinions.

- A. God's work of forming and perfecting creation prefigured God's redemption of Israel from slavery.
- B. God's work of forming and perfecting creation prefigured our redemption from sin through Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:49 - Just as we have borne the image of the earthy [Adam], we will also bear the image of the heavenly [Christ].

Romans 8:29a - For those whom He foreknew, He also <u>predestined</u> to become conformed to the <u>image</u> of His Son
