## "Meant for Good" Bible Stories Sermon Series, Pt. 12 - Gen. 37-50 October 28, 2018

## I. All Scripture Points to Christ

*Luke* 24:27 - Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

John 5:46 - For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for he wrote about Me.

## II. Joseph's Story Previews Christ's

- A. Both were their father's beloved son (Gen. 37:3).
  - Matthew 3:17 and behold, a voice out of the heavens said, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased."
  - John 3:35 The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hand.
- B. Both were rejected by their brethren (Gen. 37).
  - John 1:11 He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him.
  - John 7:5 For not even His brothers were believing in Him.
  - **Isaiah 53:3a** He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief...
- C. Both were falsely accused (Gen. 39).
  - 1. Joseph by Potiphar's wife
  - 2. Jesus by practically everyone
- D. Both suffered due to false accusations (Gen 39 and following).
  - 1. Joseph in prison
  - 2. Jesus on the cross and in the grave
- E. Both were exalted after suffering (Gen. 41:38-44).

*Philippians* 2:8–11 - <sup>8</sup> Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. <sup>9</sup> For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

F. Both brought salvation to the nations (Gen. 41:55-57).

Galatians 3:13–14 - <sup>13</sup> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"—<sup>14</sup> in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles [nations], so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

G. Both desired those who sinned against them to be with them (Gen. 45:3-5).

John 17:24 - Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world.

H. Both endured evil that God meant for good (Gen. 50:20).

Acts 2:23 - This Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men.
