Romans 8:31-32

I. Our Absolutely Unchallengeable Ally (v. 31)

- A. What shall we say to “these things”?
 - 1. Paul is referring to all of Romans so far.
 - 2. Rom. 8:31-39 is the capstone summary of God’s gospel (Rom. 1:1)
- B. God is *for* us.
 - 1. God has sided with His people.
 - 2. He is fully committed to their eternal benefit in all situations.
- C. With God as our Ally, no person or thing can truly stand against us.
- D. This should result in our having an unshakable confidence and peace.

II. Our Infinitely Trustworthy Ally (v. 32)

- A. Paul makes the argument of “the greater to the lesser”.
 - 1. If God has already done a massive thing for us...
 - 2. Then certainly He can be counted on to do comparably smaller things for us.
- B. The Greater Thing – God the Father delivered his Son to death for our sins.

Isaiah 53:10a - Yet it was the Lord’s will to crush him and cause him to suffer.
- C. The Lesser Thing – God the Father can be counted on to give us everything else we need and then some.
 - 1. In every situation.
 - 2. And forever.
